

DRESS REGULATIONS

Proper golf attire is requested - tailored shorts, slacks or skirts, golf shirt or blouse, ankle socks (on or below the ankle bone) or long socks.

Jeans (unless specified as permitted for a specific event), rugby or cargo pants, sweatshirts and billboard hats are not permitted.

At all times it is permitted to wear jeans when walking between the parking areas and the locker room.

Soft spikes or spikeless shoes are mandatory. No sandals please.

Golf wear or casual attire may be worn everywhere in the clubhouse. Shorts should not be worn in the formal dining room at any time.

For evening functions, members and guests are requested to wear a jacket and tie (gentlemen) or equivalent (ladies), unless the event is specified as casual.

CART REGULATIONS

Pull Carts should not be pulled between bunkers and greens or over tee boxes.

Power Carts – please follow the guidance of the day given on the first tee (90° rule, rough only etc). Carts should not advance past the white stakes in front of each green. Please adhere to the Cart Path Only policy on all of the Par 3 holes.

SPEED OF PLAY

A brisk Pace of Play ensures a better golf experience for everyone. Many efficient teams complete their rounds in less than 3hrs 30mins - this is our goal.

Here are some suggestions to achieve this:

- Keep up with the four ball in front of you (not ahead of the team behind you).
- Always be ready to play your shot.
- Play “ready golf” – players hit when ready, with due regard to safety.
- Line up your putt while others are putting and be ready when it is your turn.
- Move off the green quickly and mark your card on the next Tee.
- If you are delayed, please do not hesitate to signal the group behind to play through.
- Please obey the marshal – he is there to ensure a good golf experience for everyone.

JUNIORS AND GUESTS

- Juniors and guests are bound by the dress code as outlined above.
- Members are responsible for the attire of their guests.
- Young children must be appropriately dressed when using Club facilities.

If you are in doubt as to whether something is appropriate, please ask the management, the pro shop staff, the starter, the captains, or do not wear that article.
